PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, established in 2003, the Chicago Jewish Day School has created a standard of excellence in both Jewish and General Studies through integrated, multi-sensory curriculum that meets student's individual needs and gives them a passion for learning and a sense of themselves as Jews and as human beings; and

WHEREAS, the School's curriculum and daily schedule is deeply influenced by Jewish traditions, and students are taught reading, speaking, and understanding classical and modern Hebrew language and literature as well as knowledge of sacred Jewish texts and rituals, traditions and customs, and Jewish history; and

WHEREAS, the School is dedicated to being a strong community with students, teachers, and families partaking in the educational process and participating in activities that promote justice, peace, compassion, and respect across all Jewish denominations; and

WHEREAS, for the past 15 years the School has established a safe and supportive environment that allows students to shine, strive for personal excellence, and develop a strong sense of self; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday June 3, 2018, the Chicago Jewish Day School will open a new campus in the Irving Park neighborhood that includes multiple buildings with state-of-the-art classrooms, central worship and learning space, a gymnasium, and outdoor athletic and recreational facilities which will enhance the school's commitment to academic excellence and ensure continued growth:
